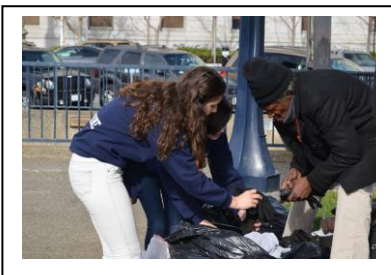


Steps for Ski Resorts
